Heather Hetherington reviewed deadlines for newsletter submission and will coordinate w/ Steve Meyer to get the sponsors logos included in the newsletter.

Dina Asmann reviewed the snackstand. We will work w/ Coca Cola for drinks, Herrs for chips and packaged foods, and Dina will stock candy directly from BJ's. We opened up a GEYA membership at BJ's w/ non profit forms so we will not have to pay sales tax. Based on volume, Coca Cola might offer us to committ to a 6 year signed contract in return for buying the league a scoreboard. Thanks to Tony Alberton & Dina's hardwork in getting the snackstand up and running! In regards to volunteers, we will have each team designate 3 time slots w/ 2 individuals covering each time slot. The intent is not to have the usual volunteers (coaches) have to cover the snackstand, but instead let some parents that do not volunteer time step up to help the league out.

Larry Hall reviewed opening day. We will have Ty Domeiy & Jeff Randazzo from Maplezone be our guest speakers. We will start the Major & Minor league ceremony at 8:30. The Rookies and Tee Ball ceremony will start at 10:30. We will offer our sponsors room to set up tables to help market to the league. The local fire department will have the ladder truck available and said that they enjoy doing these things to give back to the community. Dave Lear will be in charge of Dunkin Donuts that we will sell at concession stand. We will order 30 dozen donuts (we went through about 27 dozen), 10 dozen bagels (not very popular and we maybe went through 2 dozen), 8 urns of DD coffee that we emptied, and the snackstand provided hot chocolate and candy. The day ended up being very windy and about 45 degrees. We also had spring break starting this same weekend so attendance numbers were down-but still pretty strong!

Steve Meyer reviewed sponsorship numbers and they are coming in pretty strong. It appears that we will fall short of our goal of \$40,000 by about 20%.

Gene Jarema is waiting for equipment to come in from Oates Chevrolet(\$2,000 worth) so we can get an idea of what they are providing to the league.

We have not identified a picture day coordinator as of yet. Brian Andreesen will be out of town that weekend so we are looking for someone to step up and coordinate the schedule.
