Old Business

1. Brian Andresen presented a package from All Star Baseball Academy that includes the following:
 - 3 coaches' clinics taught by ASBA
 - Evaluations using ASBA
 - 4 indoor practices for each team in the Major Red, Major Blue, & Minor League divisionsThe initial cost would run somewhere from \$10,000 to \$12,000. It was proposed (& unanimously approved) that we would raise registration fees by \$20 per person in the Major Red, Major Blue & Minor Leagues to pay for the use of the ASBA in door facilities.
2. We need to identify someone that would be willing to order Spring/Fall uniforms. The league spends a substantial amount on uniforms so we would like to get some quotes & review. The thought of having the Major Red division get Major League Teams and the lower leagues using Minor League Teams was presented. Kevin Robinson & Tom Graybill will try to identify someone from the younger leagues to champion this for many years to come
3. Dina Asmann & Tracey Hammett will coordinate the snackstand for 2010. It was decided that we will handle the volunteers in a similar fashion as last year....each team will provide the volunteers versus the league assigning names to time slots. It was suggested that Tee Ball starts staffing first, then Major Blue & Major Red.
