



Watertown Youth Hockey – Volunteer Application

The following is a summary of the requirements associated with becoming a volunteer Coach or manager with Watertown Youth Hockey.

All Volunteers

These requirements are for all volunteers including staff, Board of Directors, coaches, managers, and any other person involved with Watertown youth hockey players.

Volunteer Application

This form, sometimes referred to as the “WYH Volunteer Application” must be completed by all volunteers. Completed forms are to be returned to Watertown Youth Hockey where they will be reviewed by the WYH Board of Directors.

Screening

The Massachusetts Criminal Offender Record Information, sometimes referred to as a “CORI”, must be applied for and submitted before the start of every hockey season.

USA Hockey Certification

All on-ice volunteers must attend USA Hockey Coaches seminars and keep their USA Hockey coaches certification current. Proof of USA Hockey compliance should be sent to the WYH Registrar prior to the start of each season.
