

**Druid Hills Youth Sports  
Travel Team Guidelines  
2013 - 2014**

**Travel Team Committee**

The Travel Team Committee shall have absolute oversight of the Travel Team program and shall have the ability to cease all activity associated with any player or the entire team. It shall be the responsibility of the Travel Team Committee to ensure that the Travel Team program is administered fairly and that each team represents DHYS to the highest possible standards of sportsmanship and conduct.

No member of the Travel Team Committee may have an age-eligible child for any of the DHYS Travel Teams, unless such member withdraws his/her player from eligibility BEFORE tryouts for any DHYS Travel Team.

Finances for all DHYS Travel Teams must be maintained exclusively by a member of the Travel Team Committee.

**Player Eligibility**

All DHYS players who played two seasons in the Bronco League including at least one spring season are eligible. Any player who has played on a DHYS travel team in a previous season is also eligible. Exceptions to the eligibility requirements for relocation, injury, and illness can be made by the DHYS Travel Team Committee. All other exceptions must be approved by a vote of the full DHYS board.

**Coaching**

The teams shall be managed by a paid coach or coaches that are not parents or guardians of any travel team player. The coaches shall be chosen by the Travel Team Committee.

**Fees**

The fees shall consist of an amount sufficient to provide payment for coaches, uniforms, equipment, tournament fees and include a payment to DHYS equal to the cost of recreational spring and fall season player fees. DHYS scholarship funds are not available to any player for Travel Team participation.

**Field Usage**

Each Travel Team shall be allowed field time as required, but always in coordination with DHYS Pony recreational teams. Schedule coordination shall be directed by the Pony League Director or the Vice President, Upper Division.
