

# DHYS 100,000 Grounder Challenge

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

**1) What exactly will the players be doing?**

Each player will rotate around multiple fields to several different stations. Each station will have different types of grounders for the players to field.

**2) What types of grounders will they be fielding?**

They will field balls rolled from coaches (pick-ups), backhand pickups, forehand pickups, grounders off a coach's bat, pick-ups from other players. Balls will be tossed, flipped, dropped into a bucket,

**3) How much money does each player have to raise?**

Our goal as a park is to raise \$100,000.00, but we are not setting a specific amount for each player to raise. We would like for each player to raise a minimum of \$100 but certainly encourage them to raise more. Prizes will be given to those who raise \$1000 or more.

**4) When will the 100,000 Grounder Challenge take place?**

We have scheduled the event for Saturday January 9, 2016. If the weather does not cooperate, we will have it on Saturday January 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**5) What is the money going to be used for?**

There are several projects around the park we have in our plans to improve: A covered batting facility, redesigning the parking lot to make it safer, ADA accessibility to fields 2 and 3. For a complete list of park improvements, see the 2016 DHYS Capital Campaign information that will be coming out in January.

**6) Can't DeKalb County pay for these upgrades?**

The reality of the situation is this: Our facilities are in desperate need of improvements. The county does not give us any money for improvements, and we do not foresee the County funding any of these improvements. We can beautify and improve so many areas if we have the resources. We can make it a great park, not just for baseball players but for all residents to enjoy.

**7) Are the donations tax-deductible?**

DHYS is a 501(c)3 organization, so all donations can be used as a tax deduction as long as a receipt is given or the check is made out to DHYS.

**8) How do we sign our son or daughter up for the 100,000 Grounder Challenge?**
