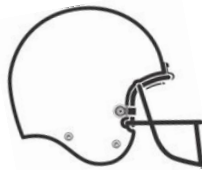

Re-use a Cleat Program If you have any lightly used cleats that you would like to donate for another player to use, please turn in to your coach at practice. If your player needs a pair of (used) cleats, please ask one of the coaches.

Field/Practice Rules

The safety of the children in our program is our top priority. Please be sure that you do not leave your child at the practice location without confirming that their coach is present and that you return a few minutes prior to the end of practice. Any details the coach may have to pass along to parents will be provided at the end of the practice.

- There is no tobacco use on the field or on the sidelines.
- Pets are not allowed on the field at any time per Park District regulations.
- Practice is cancelled if there is lightning. If there is a chance of storms, please stay at the field or close by in case your child has to be picked up.
- The speed limit in all practice parking lots is 10mph. Please obey this speed.
- Make sure you are legally parked, and pay attention to children walking in between cars.
- Parents and children need to keep the practice areas clean of all water bottles, etc. Please be sure to pick up garbage before you leave.
- No parents are allowed on the field at anytime!
- Coaches and team moms will NOT be responsible for a player's personal items. Players are responsible for their own belongings.
