WE'RE GOING TO STATE! The state competition will be held this weekend at the Sears Centre in Hoffman Estates. Coaches will share competition and arrival times with you this week. Each squad will compete on Saturday. The top three squads in each division will advance to the final round on Sunday. The cost of admission is \$11 per person, per day. (Children under 3 are free.)



Directions to the Sears Centre: The Sears Centre is located at 5333 Prairie Stone Parkway, Hoffman Estates, IL 60192. You'll want to allow approximately one hour to make the trip. Take Cedar Lake south to Rt. 120, turn right. Take Route 120 to Route 12, turn left. Route 12 will merge with South Route 59. Take South Route 59 to Hoffman Blvd, turn right. The building will be on your right.
