## PARENTS' CODE OF ETHICS

*I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in the Bethel Youth Soccer Association (BYSA) Program by following this Parents' Code of Ethics:*

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or BYSA events.

I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.

I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds the Coaches' Code of Ethics.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all BYSA events.

I will remember that the game is for youth - not for adults.

I will do my very best to make the soccer program fun for my child.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

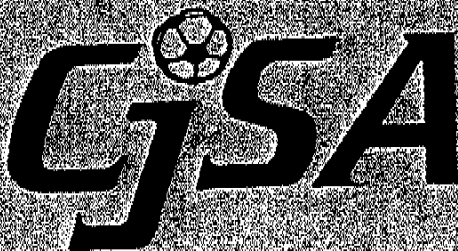
### **Please Note**
