### **PARKING**

- Parking will be at a premium at the fields, we recommend carpooling where possible.
- Please adhere to all parking signs, including handicap parking signs, both in the field lot, Highlands School lot and surrounding streets.

### **AT THE FIELDS**

- There are NO PETS permitted at the fields... Please do not bring them or ask for an exception other than aid dogs!
- There is NO SMOKING at the fields.... Please retire to one of the parking areas if necessary and dispose of properly.
- There is NO ALCOHOL permitted at the fields.
- Please observe the SPECTATOR LINES and TEAM ONLY AREAS.... The spectator area is the sideline opposite the teams, behind the spectator lines. Please do not enter the team areas or stand behind the goal lines to watch the games.
- There is no grilling allowed at the fields or in the parking areas.
