The meeting was brought to order by President Ted Kenniston in the Harvard Room at the high school. Minutes of the October 22nd meeting were read and approved by Mike Kelley and Ron Saresky. The treasurer's report was presented by Todd Peck. Motion was made by Stephanie Hogsten and seconded by Dave Landy to accept the report as given.

Old/New Business:

Food Committee Lanette Szymkowicz – Thanks to Eddie Merlott for a wonderful team meal last week. It was probably the best we've had with lots of food! We have everything in the works for the End of the Year Banquet. Please be sure you register and pay before November 7th. We still need help with set up and clean up; there is a Sign Up Genius for the times still open. There is a green 4 wheel dolly missing from the Hydration Team if anyone has seen this please let Lanette or Ted know. In reviewing the amount of money spent on the Middle School players we calculate about \$4,900 was spent and \$12,000 was raised by these two grades selling Comet Cards. This is about a 41% ratio on amount spent on them vs. what they brought in on fund raising.

Concessions, Ted & Jackie Quigley – We made \$576 Thursday at the freshman game and \$298 Saturday at the JV game. We are looking at the possibility of making \$12,000 this year through concession sales. There will be some inventory left which we believe the band and/or MABA will purchase this from us (most of the inventory is soft drinks.)

Golf Outing – we are looking for a chairperson to take over the Golf Outing next year, please let the Board know if you are interested.

Winter Social – Lisa Mullen: Social is February 2nd at Kings Island Inn. Kings Island Inn will offer rooms that night for \$54 each. We have not decided on the price of the tickets yet, we'll know better when we have secured a band and know those costs. The hotel is charging \$19.50 per person. We will get a cash bar price vs. an open bar price and make determinations from those numbers. Discussion was open on having 2 ticket prices – 1 for non-alcoholic beverages and 1 for adult beverages; this discussion was tabled pending logistics and pricing.

The floor was opened for nominations for next year's officers. There were no additional nominations made. We will accept nominations prior to the election which will be held at the November 5th meeting.
