➤ TREASURER'S REPORT

- \$19,000 in bank – @ \$10,000 is from player accounts
- With \$9000 pay for the banquet and have some to carry forward to next year - @\$4000 for banquet this year
- Still have some money owed
- 1 bill at @ \$200 for practice pinnies to be paid
- King family wants the rest of money in their account to be used for school fees – board voted and decided to leave the rest of the money in the account for the football program

➤ COACHES REPORT

- 2 challenging games coming up – try and get 1-2 wins before the end of the season
- Kids have bought into the program
- After the season lay the groundwork for moving the program forward
- This year citizenship has been good and grade improvements

- Team fund raiser in December – would like to go into next season with \$7-8000
- Jv (younger) players getting in and getting more coaching than last year
