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## MINUTES OF THE FOOTBALL BOOSTERS REGULAR MEETING

Held: Tuesday | January 19, 2016 | 7:00 p.m.

### ➤ MINUTES REVIEW & APPROVAL

- December 2015 minutes reviewed and approved.

### ➤ TREASURER'S REPORT

- Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Statement handed out
- Operating account will go down by \$2500, due to payment for 8<sup>th</sup> period weight lifting. \$500 coming in from GMJFA for youth camp (coaches did not get paid for camp this year)
- Banquet out of pocket expense @ \$1500-\$2000
- We brought in \$72,000 last year
- Tax plan – reach out to Kelly Morse again for help – if not Colette has an affordable back-up plan
- Helmets have been sent in for re-conditioning – school to pay

### ➤ COACHES REPORT

- 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Program – agility, conditioning, etc for mental and physical discipline (push them harder than they have ever been pushed before– not sure if that can do it in 8<sup>th</sup> period – need to meet 80% of requirements)
- Will do combine here shortly – spoke with Coach Manning at MSU about adapting program to high schoolers
- Glazier Clinic Feb 19-21
- CHSSA has limits on amount of contact with coaches – will do 5 day GM camp (? June 6-10) to get ready for team camp possibly at CSU Pueblo (? June 12-15)- want specific teams to be matched against
- Possibly Speed Camp, 7 on 7 (don't love it but good for timing), possibly find 7 on 7 tournament so can compete more
- Will have Summer weight lifting – would like better consistency
- Will have more suggestions to help with appropriate diet
- 3 Youth Single Day camps during Summer - free camps for youth to play positions they really want to try playing
- Pushing for Aspire – Pepsi contract to end soon

- Possibly bring back golf tournament
- OTAs (to implement schemes) if don't run out of time
- Study Tables – use Learning Center to help kids struggling with poor grades – if have an 'F' will not play
- 4 captains will be named Friday by coach
- Recruiting – coach will be honest with the players about where they can play in college – starting to get set up with some schools
- Will offer Coach Griffin (8<sup>th</sup> grade coach) freshman position so that he will bring his players here
- Equipment – want new uniforms to re-brand the program – new jerseys (black and white) and get white pants, horns on helmets
- Want end zone cameras – possibly shared with other Jeffco schools or we buy and rent to other schools
- Would like to get more involvement with students and community for homecoming
- Keep jerseys from under Coach Ward for freshman
- Returning coaches – Muir, Schaller, Thede and asked Cale (not sure due to busy schedule)
- Would like to do Rent-A-Ram fundraiser (players get out and do projects people need done) – combo community service and fundraiser

#### ➤ NEW BUSINESS/ FUND RAISING

- Try and sell old jerseys or donate to another program for tax write off
- Sell jerseys to seniors - \$50 for 1 or \$75 for both
- Bi-Laws – not able to locate old set even going through old books and talking to previous Booster Club Members - had to re-write several sections – check Section 8 regarding duties
- Motion passed to extend nominations through Jan 31 – to be voted on at Feb meeting – will send email about nominations and ability to shadow board members to learn about positions on the board
- Ram Card issues – Fundraising University – cost of cards was set too high and Winter Park deal not valid (they are making good if specific complaints)– need to look at other companies that do it
- Programs for next year – possibly incorporate band and cheerleaders - ? including other teams
- Communication of board members – get cell numbers as each board member said this is best form of communication of it needs to happen more quickly than emails
- Thunder Valley June 4 –
  - need about 25 adults
  - possibly have people walk around selling beer, water, and soda will get more involved ahead of time so organized and ready to sell
  - Walt and Colette will get more involved ahead of time so organized and ready to sell
