### ➤ MINUTES REVIEW & APPROVAL

- February 2016 minutes reviewed and approved.

### ➤ TREASURER'S REPORT

- See printed reports P&L, 2016 Budget produced by treasurer
- GMJFA paid \$500 from camp last year
- Account balances: Player \$9762, Operating Account \$3932
- Treasurer's report approved

### ➤ COACHES REPORT

- Jesse German DC – came and met with players last week
- Kevin Hyland WR's/JV head coach – from NY
- James Romero- D Assistant
- Hiring 1 more assistant – Varsity defense/JV D-Coordinator
- 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Program – going very well and great turnout
  - Freshmen T and Th 26 today at Dunstan
  - Will end earlier than planned so kids can focus on exams
  - 2 200 lb tires donated today- will get 2 more
  - Weight program – Cale doing a great job
  - Set up committee to oversee whole season and include nutrition
- Week of July 25 meeting with GMJFA to plan camp and get something in writing about expectations and what we will bring (guest lecturers)
- March Purchases
  - Hudl due March 31 - \$1000
  - End Zone Camera- decided on model that is \$200 more but will allow tie in to ipads so they can be running for coaches in the booth during games
  - New uniforms( now 80), coaches gear, helmets painted (Schutt is doing) - \$20K
  - Tires donated
  - Would like to get Juggs machine donated
- Remind.com – new and best way for communications for team events and activities – players(need to) and parents can sign up – text @coachpees to 81010

- Freshmen welcome Night – Th April 14<sup>th</sup> in Commons – will ask for RSVP by 1 week before
- Rent-a-Ram – need someone to organize
- Study Tables – implement end of semester
- Recruiting – putting packet together to help kids that want to play in college – they have to express interest to coach to get help
- Website – school will have football website for us, but don't have to use
  - Owner of Voice Media Group may donate build of website (\$1500) – it is between us and East High School
- Participation
  - Last year 62 players
  - Currently 102 players – 32 freshmen, 70 varsity and jv
  - 14 more trying to get that are not eligible
  - Have cut players with F's to 1/3 of what they were 1 week ago

#### ➤ NEW BUSINESS/ FUND RAISING

- Butter Braid orders need to be in by March 14 and delivery March 18
- Mulch – looking at 5 companies to work with – trying to get wholesale - \$5-\$7 per bag retail – start 1<sup>st</sup> week of April and go thru April 22, delivery week of April 25
- Focus shift – Ram Cards – going with University from last year because they say all issues fixed and if not we can cancel and go with Legacy. Also getting higher percentage – 70% and sell for \$20 – will change the look of it to new logo – Chris (new rep) said he thinks we can make \$27,000
- Pictures for programs 1<sup>st</sup> week or 2 of practice – Aug 15<sup>th</sup> first official day of practice
- Banquet – will check into Sheraton in Lakewood or Denver West Marriott since more people attending – will try and book now since don't have to pay but want specific date

#### ➤ WEBSITE INFO

- League Athletics (current website) – we may be able to use info from new company as leverage because they may think we are leaving – will compare both to see which makes the most sense. League Athletics has recently been purchased
- Possibly have students intern in taking care of website

#### ➤ ACTION ITEMS

- **Coach to get contact info of students in media class for Bridget for programs and banners**
- **Coach starting now to work on change content for website**
- **Coach and Sarah to try and meet with current website company next week**
- **Coach to contact BSN about store for players and parents to order spirit wear**
