MINUTES OF THE FOOTBALL BOOSTERS REGULAR MEETING

Held: Tuesday | May 3, 2016 | 5:00 p.m.

The meeting came to order at 5:35 p.m. The following Green Mountain High School Football Boosters were in attendance:

➤ MINUTES REVIEW & APPROVAL

- April 2016 minutes reviewed and approved.

➤ TREASURER'S REPORT

- Mulch fundraiser -16 players participated and made a little over \$2000
- Walt Schattinger donating the mulch
- Going out this month - \$140 for order forms for mulch, &500 to school for old debt from Wallen ordering bands, \$200 to coach for coaching clinic, \$150 for pizza for freshmen night
- Will have leftover money from senior accounts that will move into operating account

➤ COACHES REPORT

- Rent-A-Ram – finalizing how to do it and getting approval from Jeffco. 1st to launch in the state. Waiting to hear back from risk manager on a few things.
- We need to create a waiver for RAR – anyone have legal person on staff to help with proper verbiage – need 1 for parents of kids under 18 and 1 for clients using the service of that Ram
- It will be a ‘voluntary’ amount for people to pay us – recommended amount \$10/hr
- We need to provide safety goggles if they are mowing.
- Tumblers – last individual fundraiser – will start at parent meeting - \$20 each and not held accountable for a specific number to sell – trying to help with re-branding
- Thunder Valley June 4th – would like to get ok to do this fundraiser for the team for the next 4 years from Dave?
- Big Team Fundraisers – Rent-A-Ram, Thunder Valley and Ram Cards
- Mulch in March will be the only individual sale – will have it right there to buy and take with you – Also launch RAR in March (try and put the 2 together, rent a ram to deliver and lay your mulch
- Parent Nights – May 5th – freshmen – will have pizza, May 12th all others – will have packet handouts but info will also be on website – talk about shadowing opportunities at both meetings.

- Stipends – trainer and fields lined as part of budget - \$600 each, Summer weight class (40 days) \$500 to split up between coaches that run the program, Video coordinator \$1500 (hopefully Summer weight money will cover paying coaches for weights and video coordinator
- Video coordinator 12-15 hours/wk, Thursday practice and then 3 games/wk
- Will have Monday night film at 6 pm – parents can watch only for 1st 45 mins then when players leave can comment or question
- Budget – uniforms \$18,335 total so under budget
 - Coach's gear
 - 4th Quarter Program – need to order \$3800 worth of gear that players earned and only budgeted \$1000
 - Decals for helmets - \$1000
 - HUDL/EDGE - \$1000 for 12 hrs of film –upgrade \$600 more will get 40 hours of film. EDGE - \$1200-\$1800(money for additional device –IPAD) would get 1 immediate playback tied to camera, so could see in press box
 - Player Cleats – will get a good deal from UA (\$75 per pair)– would like to attach this as goal for 4th quarter program. This year thinking about if they sell 30 Ram Cards they will get a pair of cleats
 - Transportation – 7 on 7 tournament in Eaton July 9 – leave by 6:30 am, and Team Camp June 12-14 leave at 8 am the 12th and come back from Greeley at 3 pm
- Key Dates – see printed list
- 13 kids have been terminated from the program as of now for bad grades(they need to focus on their grades at this time), 20 others are close

➤ NEW BUSINESS/ FUND RAISING

- Banquet set temporarily for Wed Dec 7 6-10 pm at Baldoria. Will check Sheraton to see what is available if we have more players. We will end up with more than last year for sure.
- Booster Club meetings – 1 x/month is not enough for Sarah to get everything done because she needs to be in touch with different members about getting things done.
- Spirit Wear – will not go through coach's group – will check with Sportline about getting a page where people can go to order
- Team Dinners – Patty and Beth taking care of organizing. On Thursdays will have JV and varsity – may talk with freshmen parents about an option for them, but they will have to do on their own
- Parent suggestion for pom poms for crowd at homecoming
- Any contacts that come directly to booster club members we should try and route to yahoo email before we leave our BC positions
- Possibly purchase a website (Doodle or Where I Work) to run RAR @ \$200-300 – ids can put in black-out dates, accept a job, get text reminders through their phones, etc.
- Stacey Heaton and Rachael Alford 2 of 4 parents that will be helping the running of RAR
- Thunder Valley – Will have sign ups through website on volunteer button and will talk about volunteering at parent meetings – will need about 40 parent volunteers

- Possibly have students intern in taking care of website

➤ ACTION ITEMS

- HUDL/EDGE upgrade
- Erika follow-up with Sportline about getting a page to order spirit wear
- Transportation – charge players for team camp, which is covered in general fund for camp – Bridget will check into pricing for buses
- Several people looking into waivers for RAR
- Sarah and Jenny will get together and reconcile senior accounts and money there to general fund
