Up tonight is the Girls varsity team in the State Class L semi-finals versus Greenwich. Game time for the Warriors is 6:00pm at Brien McMahon High School in Norwalk. The second semi-final game (All FCIAC semis) between Darien and New Canaan follows at 8pm for all the lacrosse junkies out there. The girls team is coming off impressive victories against #6 seed Glastonbury (14-9) and #3 seed Cheshire (16-8) last week. Wilton beat Greenwich earlier this year 8-7 so you can be sure the Cardinals are looking for revenge. The rain looks like it will have ended so come out tonight and cheer the girls on. The game is also on the HAN Network.

The Boys varsity follows with their State Class L semi-final game against Chesire tomorrow night (Wednesday) at Rafferty Stadium on the campus of Fairfield University at 7:15pm. The other semi-final game between #1 seed Darien (and #1 nationally) and #5 seed Glastonbury starts at 5pm at the same location. Wilton, the #6 seed, played two strong games last week, defeating #11 Xavier 15-6 and then soundly defeating #3 seed Fairfield Prep 12-5 on Saturday. Wilton has not played Chesire this year so it promises to be a great match-up. It looks like you will have to come in person as at the moment HAN does not appear to have it on their schedule.

The youth teams are also finishing up their season this week. Last weekend the 5<sup>th</sup> /6<sup>th</sup> graders had their CONNY tournaments up at Yale – girls on Saturday and boys on Sunday. On the girls side 2 teams won their bracket while the other two finished as runners up. Also last weekend was the Massachusetts/Connecticut border battle with the boys youth teams up in Avon and Loomis Chaffee. Apparently there was some very strong competition and all the games were tight which is exactly why we do these jamborees. Great work by all the players and coaches.
