Especially important for business that are already supporting Lake Region. Charitable gambling has been significantly more difficult since the smoking ban and the more we can do as an association to promote ourselves when visiting local businesses, the easier it will be to gain their support.

Marc also presented a request for association membership to help urge the New Brighton City Council to support a statue that established guidelines around charitable gambling that requires the recipients to be local. Currently, most nearby cities have similar statutes. New Brighton does

not, so there are a number of New Brighton establishments with Pull Tabs supporting out of town organizations.
