Proof of Residency

Proof of Residency will be required on or before a player's first skate for all returning players. (New players to NDMHA this year have already supplied all required documentation so are not required to show proof of residency again.) Returning players will not be allowed on the ice unless a proof of residency in North Delta is provided. Acceptable documents include:

- Property Tax Bill
- BC Hydro Bill
- Fortis Gas Bill
- Cable TV/Internet Bill

We will not accept cell phone bills or driver's licences.

Documents can be brought to a player's first practice, or dropped off in advance at the NDMHA Hockey Office or Sungod Reception Desk (be sure to tell them it is for the NDMHA mail slot.) Be sure to write the player's full name and Division on the Document, as well as if they play Rep or "C".
