If paying by cheque, registration is not complete until you have both registered on line and we have received your cheques. All cheques must be submitted to the Hockey office by the end of the day on July 15th as the mail will be picked by 9:00 pm that evening. Any cheques received following July 15th 9:00 pm will be subject to a \$50.00 late fee. Registration is not complete until payment is received. If paying by credit card, payment receipt is immediate. As of today, there are at least 300 players that have yet to register.
