



# Hockey 2 to Juvenile Registration Info RETURNING PLAYER

## Welcome back to North Delta Minor Hockey

North Delta Hockey is a non-profit society created to provide the children of our community, ages 5 through 20, with the opportunity to play league hockey in an environment that promotes and teaches all aspects of the sport of hockey. Ice scheduling, coach assigning and association organizational duties require that registration take place well in advance of the hockey season. Registrations are processed as they are received and waiting lists will be kept as necessary.

### How to Register

- No returning player registrations will be accepted manually on paper
- To log on, use your email address that you used last season to register. If you forgot your password, or user ID, contact the Registrar at [registrar@ndhockey.com](mailto:registrar@ndhockey.com)
- Early bird registration will open on June 24, 2019.
- Early bird registration will close July 31, 2019.
- Early bird registration is eligible for a \$100 reduction to fees for H2 - Juvenile. Once closed regular fee rates apply.
- Registration fees may be paid by credit card; cheques and cash will not be accepted.
- **Rep try out registration must be completed by July 31, 2019. Please ensure you make your decision regarding rep-try out prior to deadlines, otherwise you may be subject to a \$50 late fee.**

### Residency Check

- Residency checks are done on an annual basis.

- Acceptable documents are; BC Hydro statement, Fortis statement, Cable bill, Property tax notice, (phone bills are not acceptable),
- Documents should be for July - August 2019.
- Please send in residency documents between August 1-21 for Rep A and Aug – Sept 1 for Rep C (House).

### What Do Your Registration Fees Cover

- Ice rental, jerseys, membership in governing associations, administration.
- League fees, Hockey insurance for players, coaches, referees and trainers (not dental aid or wage loss)
- Development
- Referee payments for league games (Hockey 3 to Juvenile)

### Refund Policy

- See our website for refund form and instructions. No refunds will be processed until October 1 and no funds after December 1.

## **Further Information About Registration Fees**

- For families with three children registered in ND Hockey: Hockey 2 to Juvenile will receive a \$100 discount that will apply to your youngest child. (Note: Hockey 1 is already discounted for all players and is not eligible).
- Goalies (Atom Division and above) who supply their own equipment are entitled to a \$100 goalie rebate. Rebate request must be received **before February 1**. See "Forms" tab on website under "management forms".
- The custodial parent is responsible for signing of all forms and all financial responsibilities
- The custodial parent's residential address determines eligibility to play in ND Hockey. Custody agreements may be required to be forwarded to PCAHA for approval.

## **Juvenile Jersey Deposit**

- Juvenile players have a \$250 jersey deposit that is refundable at end of season when jersey is returned.

## **Rental of Goalie Equipment**

- ND Hockey provides goalie equipment to rent for the current season for interested members. This rental fee is an individual responsibility. Please inquire with the Equipment Manager (equipmentmanager@ndhockey.com) regarding the procedures for rental.

## **On Ice Officials**

- ND Hockey welcomes both returning and new officials to its program. If you are second year PeeWee, 12 years of age or older and would like to become an on-ice official, please contact our Referee in Chief at ric@ndhockey.com. The number of new officials this year will be limited.

## **Equipment and Equipment Check**

- All equipment must be purchased prior to the start of the season. Please check the website for more details on equipment requirements.
- Prior to Rep Tryouts and/or Player Evaluations, all members will be required to have an equipment check by our Team Officials to ensure all required equipment is present.

## **Team Fees    *Team fees are in addition to registration fees***

- Team fees are determined following team formation through a budget proposal. The budget is presented by team officials, and agreed to by a majority of parents. These fees must be paid by the end of the season. Failure to comply may place the non-compliant member in a "**member not in good standing**" status which could result in the forfeiting of all rights of that member.

## **Team Placement – Hockey 1 to 4 only**

- If you would like to request a team placement, a separate letter stating specific reasons must accompany this registration form. Both families must submit a separate letter. ND Hockey cannot guarantee that all requests will be granted.

## **Rep Teams - Atom, PeeWee, Bantam, Midget and Juvenile**

- All players should be committed to performing to their best ability. It should be every Rep player's goal to play at the top tier of our Association. Families should fully consider the commitment of Rep level hockey when registering. Rep players must play within their correct age group (division). Movement between divisions is not permitted.

## **Rep Tryouts**

- Please check the www.ndhockey.com website for dates and times of tryouts.
- Any player who will not be available at this time must inform the 1st Vice President at vp1@ndhockey.com in writing prior to the commencement of tryouts.

### **Major and Minor Zone Teams**

- Please see BC Hockey website [www.bchockey.net](http://www.bchockey.net) for more information regarding the Major and Minor Zone Leagues. Please note if released from a zone program you must attend at least one tryout and pay the (amount) Rep Tryout fee to be eligible for the ND Rep program.

### **Players Attending Junior Camps**

- Players should still register for ND Minor Hockey. Registered players attending Junior camps or those signed temporarily with a Junior organization are not guaranteed REP A placement in ND Hockey upon their release.
- Players must attend at least one tryout and pay the (amount) Rep Tryout fee to be eligible for the ND Rep program.

### **Medical Information Forms**

- Each season players will need to submit a medical information form. The information is kept for the current season only to provide emergency information to the team HCSP's. New information will be collected each season.
