Parent Guidelines

- Remain in the spectator area
- Let the coach be the coach
- Provide only supportive comments to coaches, officials, and players of both teams. Avoid derogatory comments.
- Do not coach your son or daughter during the contest
- Do not indulge in the use of alcohol, or drugs while attending RAYLA events
- Show interest, enthusiasm, and support for your child and others on his/her team
- Be in control of your emotions
- Help when asked by coaches and/or officials
- Promptly report any instances of bullying or inappropriate behaviors you witness by any RAYLA player on or off the field
- Any conversation about a playing time will be in person with the head coach. The player will lead a guided conversation with the coach and the parent to discuss their concerns.
- I have discussed and made my player to understand the players code of conduct and agree to hold them responsible to that agreement

Basic Responsibility

“I will represent Roseville Area Youth Lacrosse Association with my personal best efforts, never bringing embarrassment or an unfavorable view to my team, coaches, family or RAYLA or community”.

Penalty

Abuse brings restrictions. A penalty may vary from a minimum of one game (or event) suspension from attending a RAYLA event to permanent restriction for that season and the following sport season.
