Players Pledge

- I will treat each athlete, coach, parent, and official with respect and dignity
- I will do my best to attend all practices to learn the fundamental skills, and be attentive to game strategies
- I will contact my coach if I am unable to attend a game or practice
- I will accept the calls of the officials and will play by the rules of the game
- I will give my personal best efforts at all times to help my team and coaches
- I will treat all equipment, fields, courts and facilities with respect and adhere to all rules
- I will control my emotions and myself so I don't hurt myself or those around me
- I will not attempt to bully any player on my team or an opposing team
- I will not use profanity
