The minutes to the April 2012 FCFL were approved.

Treasurer's Report – Carmen Roda

No town has paid their dues yet. Dues will be \$1,500 per town and are due by the next meeting. There are no financial issues. .

New Business –

- Discussions surrounded coordination of uniforms within FCFL. Weston inquired whether their uniforms would conflict with other FCFL teams. Mike Cagnetta indicated that New Canaan may have 3 teams at some levels and those teams would most likely have white jerseys.
- Referees – There is no anticipated increase in fees for referees this season. A grading system for referees is being examined.
- Rules and Policy changes will need to be instituted into the policy and rule documents onto the website.
- Discussions ensued on procedures for checking in players with respect to the new unlimited weights for limited players. The procedure will be generally the same as in the past; however limited players will not need to weigh in.
- At the August meeting, all towns will need to present their slate of coaches and verify that all coaches have met their CDC certifications.
- Mitch Ross presented a proposed FCFL scheduling document. The protocol for scheduling within the document is to be approved at the next meeting. There was also a discussion about moving to divisional play in order to eliminate the potential for intra-town playoff games. This will also be discussed at the next meeting.
- All towns should know their availability of fields for the jamboree the weekend of August 25/26 by the next FCFL meeting.
- There was a discussion about a Fairfield player who has moved to Westport but still maintains a residence in Fairfield. It was decided that the player should register to play on where he wants to play.
- Tom O’Dea presented New Canaan initiatives which include baseline testing at the Connecticut Concussion Clinic.
- The next FCFL meeting will be June 27 so as to not conflict with the July 4 holiday.
- The August meeting will be held on August 15.
