Started his coaching career in 1999 with the Women's program at Texas Tech University. Andrew began his club coaching in 2002, coaching in the Dallas and West Texas area before heading off to Florida.

Andrew began working for the Storm program and quickly was promoted to Technical Development Director. He helped guide the program to their first ever top 25 Soccer America Club ranking. Andrew's team would capture several Florida State Championships.

His teams would also go on to win some of the Nation's top tournament's like the Disney Showcase. In 2012, his team would win the Southern Regional Championship one of the Nation's most prestigious leagues. Andrew would help produce some of the best female soccer players in the country.

Several of his player's would be invited to play for the US Youth National teams and were highly recruited by some of the Nation's top colleges. Before moving to Utah Andrew was awarded the coach of the year award in 2012 and 2010.

Andrew is a staff member for the Utah Olympic Program and in 2013 was awarded the Utah Coach of the month award. In 2016, Andrew helped guide one of the first ever Storm teams to a regional finalist at President's Cup.

Andrew holds his Exercise Sport Science Degree from Texas Tech University and the United States Soccer Federation "B" license.
