Review of what's happening / happened

1. Friendly's Fundraiser Complete on 12/6, raised \$95. Brian / Wendy to schedule another for Saturday 1/25/2014
2. Registration for 2014 available online and via paper. Brian to contact schools (e-mail sent on 12/30 to assistant superintendent of schools) about sending home a copy of the paper from with all elementary and middle school kids in January and or February.
3. "Registration Open" signs received. Brian to contact planning office to get approval to post signs around town on town property. Will also put up in front a few peoples houses (Joe and Chris ?)
4. Annual Charter Forms Complete – Chris to mail in form with check to LL regional office.
5. Fences – Approval given to Fence One to go ahead with the work at their convenience.

Umpires: Al and Rick coordinate for WL. Cecilia to exchange their information with Jeff. About \$1,500-\$2,000 for fees associated with higher leagues (ex. AA - high school)

Fundraising: Chris to re-send list of sponsors. Input information with new sponsors, if applicable. Different levels captured on flyer by Chris and updated by year-end (adding Diamond level for \$750 and differentiating the balance); looking for \$10k in sponsorships in 2014

Grant: baseball tomorrow application being processed; potential consideration for fencing, storage shed/container, batting cage, lighting, etc. Question raised as to investment potential versus nature/extent of use (considering limited season)

Budget: deferred until next meeting

Equipment: Dave conducted a preliminary inventory of the shack and locked up the equipment. A more thorough inventory is required to determine 2014 needs. Need to rebuild helmet racks.
