Football – John Mulvaney reported the end of season survey is almost completed, preparing next season's budget with Seton.

Girls Volleyball – Judy Suddendorf reported that the coaches list will be submitted shortly for approval. A discussion was held regarding Spandex shorts for use by girls. Father has indicated that Spandex is not approved. Brad Bursa reported that he researched Volleyball uniforms with Franciscan University that there the women wear Softe shorts. Brad will submit to Father for approval that 7th and 8th grade girls may wear the Softe shorts with Spandex underneath.

Boys Basketball – Bob Siebert reported that the scoreboard manual has been prepared, concessions cabinet repaired, coaches shirts to be ordered. Bob is looking to add players to one of the 8th grade teams. Bob is organizing a day of community service for the program with Matthew 25 Ministries.
