EXCEPTION: If a pitcher reaches a day(s) of rest threshold while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until that batter reaches base or that batter is retired, or the third out is made to complete the half-inning. The pitcher will only be required to observe the calendar day(s) of rest for the threshold he/she reached during the at-bat, provided that pitcher is removed before delivering a pitch to another batter.

EXCEPTION: If a pitcher reaches the max # of pitches for his/her league age while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until the batter reaches base, is put out, or the half inning ends.

NOTE: A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day.

NOTE: Any player, who has who has played the position of catcher in four (4) or more innings in a game, is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day.

Majors / 50-70 / Junior / Senior / Big League: The batter becomes a runner when the third strike called by the umpire is not caught, providing (1) first base is unoccupied or (2) first base is occupied with two out.

NOTE: Intentional Walk - Four pitches must be thrown by the pitcher that are called balls by the home plate umpire.
