North Polk High School and Middle School Campus

- All games will be played in Alleman, Iowa on full-court wood floors with bleacher seating for spectators.
- Tournament fee will be \$165. Admission for adults will be \$5 each tournament day.
 - Free admission for students and children
- Concessions will be provided. No coolers or outside food/beverage allowed.
- 3 game guarantee.
- Tournament format will be determined by the amount of teams entered. 8 teams will be the maximum for each division.
- Players must live in the same school district. No All-Star teams.
- Players may “play up”, but no player may “play down a grade”.
- All games will be played under IHSAA and IGHSAA rules (except where noted below) and will be officiated by two certified basketball officials.
- A 3 minute warm-up will be guaranteed for each game.
- Games will consist of two 20 minute “running clock” halves. Clock will stop in the last two minutes of the second half if score of game is within 9 points or less.
- Halftime will be 3 minutes.
- Teams will be allowed 3 one-minute timeouts per game.
- Tie scores will be broken by a sudden death overtime period using alternate position. Each team will be guaranteed one offensive possession. First possession will be determined by possession arrow at the end of the game.
- 4th, 5th & 6th grade: Man-to-man defense must be played at all times. Proper help-side principles will be allowed. No zone defense at any time.
 - Full-Court press will only be allowed in the last 2 minutes of the game if score of game is within 10 points or less. The losing or tied teams must initiate the press for both teams, otherwise no pressing allowed.
- 7th grade: Zone defense and full-court press may be played, except...
 - No team ahead by 10 or more points may full-court press
- The home team will be denoted by the team at the top of the tournament bracket or by first team listed in pool play. The home team is to wear white or light-colored jerseys.
- For 4th & 5th grade, the home team will obtain the first possession of the game. For 6th & 7th grade, a jump ball will start the game.
 - Alternating possessions thereafter, including the start of overtime.
- 4th grade girls will shoot free throws from 12 feet.
- For 10 team members, trophies to Champions and medals to 2nd, 3rd and Consolation.
- **GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IS A BASIC EXPECTATION. TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO ASK THOSE NOT DISPLAYING SUCH BEHAVIOR TO LEAVE THE SCHOOL'S PROPERTY.**

Coaches will be responsible for their players and spectators while on school property.
