There have been some questions and concerns with a few things so we wanted to follow up on those and make sure everyone has the correct information.

JMC - The EYHA Board regrets to inform you that we still have no solid answer on the ice situation at JMC. Sean Carroll talked to Scott Mitchell today and the word is they are pulling the refrigerant back out of the system and are going to weigh it. There are currently two spots that are not getting cool enough. He did not indicate what the next step will be and gave no projected time for the rink to be operational. We will continue to be in contact with him on a weekly basis. We thank you for your patience in this matter and share in your frustration. We will continue to do the best we can with scheduling ice and keeping you informed.

ICE/Scheduling – We, as the Board are doing the best we can to schedule everyone consistently and equally. We understand that this is not easy and can be inconvenient. Everyone is struggling! Our scheduler, who volunteers several hours a day, which takes a lot of patience and frustration, trying to accommodate everyone the best she can.

Website – There is ability for the team manager or a parent to enter and upload information/pictures onto the website and the SI App. You can also sync certain items from SI and the website together.

If you wanted an announcement/picture/fundraiser information/etc. posted on the main page, you would need to give ALL information to Johnny McFadden, the Web Administrator.

Double Rinks – Also, there has been a lot of misleading and incorrect information about the purchase of Family First by the non-profit organization, G.R.E.A.T. With that being said, we are happy to inform you that the closing on the property will be within the next 30 days. Obviously, this will not help resolve any ice issues for this year, but they anticipate the rinks be ready around next summer! If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the Board.

Board/Questions – Anyone is always welcome to contact the board with a question, issue, or to report an incident. A board member can present a motion on your behalf or you can request to come to a board meeting if necessary. We anticipate having open board meeting once a month for the entire organization.
