

Per the state's updated COVID-19 protocols relating to mask requirements and youth sports, we have concurrently updated Wellesley Youth Baseball and Softball's protocols.

Effective immediately, masks are now optional for all players and umpires under the age of 19. For any coaches, spectators, or umpires over the age of 19, masks are optional so long as you can maintain social distance. If you cannot maintain social distance, masks are still required.

We understand the updated youth sports guidance is a change from the League's previously followed COVID-19 protocols. As a result, we encourage all players, coaches, and spectators to maintain social distance whenever possible.

In closing, please remember that our goals continue to be to create a safe and fun environment for all participants. Keeping our kids on the field remains the priority. We are fortunate to live in a community where many of our coaches and spectators are fully vaccinated and understand the importance of safety.
