Sideline Quick Restarts

Clarification on side line ball out of bounds 'Quick restarts'

When the ball goes out of bounds on the sidelines (in the boy's game), the player is to retrieve the ball (or pick up the spare balls on the sideline), step in bounds and ready himself for play. The officials will blow his whistle when play is ready to continue. We will try to make that as quickly as possible, but there may be times when the field of play is NOT ready for play (the goalie is not in the crease as an example) and the whistle will be held.

Coaches are asked to teach their players that sideline OOB is the same as 'end line OOB' after a shot is taken. The player can NOT pick up the ball and start play BEFORE the whistle is blown to restart play.
