GLL is an approved US Lacrosse league honoring US Lacrosse Rules and Best Practices. GA Chapter USL President is a GLL Association Director.



The GLL is comprised of 13 Associations. The directors you elect from each association write, approve and ratify the league rules and guidelines. The GLL Executive Board oversees the overall integrity of the league, its by-laws and administration of the director's decisions and ratified by-laws and rules. Each association has one vote. In an effort to be more transparent the league will post minutes from director's meetings so you can see how your directors are working to make lacrosse a fun and safe environment for your children. The Association Directors have been busy already as you will see by the following implementations for 2014.

The 2014 season will commence February 8th at the request of John Register from Gwinnett County Parks and Recreation. Scheduling will be up a week after final rosters and team numbers have been created. The GLL will have an extra week to prepare the schedule this year with the Feb 8th start date. Expected games played to be 10-12 based on playoff success. The GLL is working to implement a new web site that should make access of schedules easier for all.

In 2014 the GLL directors voted to use e-forms for easier on line registration. Stay tuned to hear more as you begin to register your children.

In 2014 The GLL Girl's Senior Division will attempt to have a select division called "Iroquois" for the higher level play amongst our programs.

In 2014 US Lacrosse has adopted the GLL bench side "Rep" position naming these "Sideline Managers". In an attempt to keep your child's experience safe and fun for all the GLL Association Directors have elected to provide these persons as a responsibility of the host parks. USL Rule 1 of Section 12 / 2014 Rules for 204 Boys Youth Lacrosse.

In 2014 the GLL will offer to Senior & Junior Iroquois boys as well as Senior girls an opportunity to play as many as (4) games outside the GLL in "non-conference" games.

In 2014 the GLL Boys once again will have select divisions called "Iroquois" and "Cherokee" in Junior (5th - 6th) & Senior (7th and 8th) grade divisions.

2014 Association Directors have voted to make uniform selection an option of two companies. Once again the directors have kept the uniform cost under \$65.00 per player for sublimated reversible jersey uniforms.

The Association Directors decided to disperse the cost of paying for referees from a \$3 per head gate fee by assessing each player during registration thus eliminating the gate entrance fee for the 2014 season. Looking at the costs the directors determined that

a family of three would spend as much as \$65.00 on gate fees for a season.

The 2014 Association Directors voted to abolish the Boys lightning pass rules. The Directors voted to keep the rule for Bantam boys.

The 2014 GLL Association Directors have created a Girls Board of Directors with a girl's director from each association focusing solely on girl's related goals and objectives.

The 2014 Association Directors will vote unanimously to keep and modify the one pass rule for "Girl's Lightning" for the 2014 season.

The 2014 Association Directors voted to keep the "league rep" participation from associations on the spectator side of the fields. These will be trained association members working to keep your environment safe and fun for all.
