**CODE OF CONDUCT**  
 The Gwinnett Lacrosse League (GLL) is a recreational youth lacrosse program that strives to teach sports skills and techniques in an atmosphere where good sportsmanship, physical fitness, and enjoying the program are stressed. The parents, spectators, and participants must at all times conduct themselves with the utmost good character and display behavior that is in keeping with the purpose of the GLL. Improper conduct directed towards coaches, officials, or players will not be tolerated. Consumption or possession of alcohol, any controlled substance, or tobacco products at any Gwinnett Lacrosse League activity whether a practice or game is prohibited. Profanity will not be tolerated. Strict adherence to the rules of the GLL is required. Your coach has been provided an up-to-date copy of the GLL rules. As a parent or guardian, you acknowledge that you have been made aware of the GLL Code of Conduct and that you understand your obligations as it pertains to the Code of Conduct. You agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of the Code of Conduct and understand that it is your responsibility to see that all that attend games and practices with you are also so bound. You further understand that the GLL Board of Directors is empowered to enforce all provisions of the Code of Conduct as well as the rules and By-laws of the Gwinnett Lacrosse League, Inc. and that if you violate the terms and conditions of the Code of Conduct, the By-laws, or the rules and regulations, you can be barred from further participation in all GLL activities.

**EMERGENCY MEDICAL AND SURGICAL TREATMENT AND RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS**  
 The patient and others whose signatures are attached below do hereby consent to any and all medical and surgical treatments including anesthesia and operations which may be deemed advisable by his or her physicians and surgeons. The intention hereof being to grant authority to administer and to perform all and singularly any examinations, treatments, anesthetics, operations and diagnostic procedures which may now or during the course of the patient's care be deemed advisable or necessary. We also agree that the patient, when admitted, is to remain in the hospital until his or her physician recommends the patient's discharge and to pay all bills incurred. NOTE: I assume all risks and hazards incidental to such participation including transportation to and from the activities and participation in practices and games and I do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the Gwinnett Lacrosse League, Inc. and/or any of its member associations, including officers, organizers, sponsors, managers, coaches, supervisors, and other participants and persons transporting my child to and from the activities from any claim arising out of injury to my child.

**GRADE BASED / AGE-BASED PROGRAM - LACROSSE**  
 GLL is an grade based recreational lacrosse league. Many lacrosse players vary tremendously in height and weight even within the same category. All participants in GLL lacrosse must participate at their grade level irrespective of their size or other physical limitations. Under special circumstances the GLL Executive Board will take a players petition under consideration and advisement. By completing this section, you are acknowledging you have been advised of this information prior to registering and that you nevertheless wish for your child to participate in the GLL lacrosse program.  
 Games that are postponed due to inclement weather, field conditions, etc. may be rescheduled to play on Sunday. Due to field availability and other scheduling issues your team may not play all games at their association parks. Please acknowledging that you are aware that games at the home association park/field are NOT guaranteed.

**GLL PLAYER / PARENT CONCUSSION AWARENESS**  
**DANGERS OF CONCUSSION**  
 Concussions at all levels of sports have received a great deal of attention and a state law has been passed to address this issue. Adolescent athletes are particularly vulnerable to the effects of concussion. Once considered little more than a minor "ding" to the head, it is now understood that a concussion has the potential to result in death, or changes in brain function (either short-term or long-term). A concussion is a brain injury that results in a temporary disruption of normal brain function. A concussion occurs when the brain is violently rocked back and forth or twisted inside the skull as a result of a blow to the head or body. Continued participation in any sport following a concussion can lead to worsening concussion symptoms, as well as increased risk for further injury to the brain, and even death. Player and parental education in this area is crucial - that is the reason for this document. Refer to it regularly. This form must be signed by a parent or guardian of each student who wishes to participate in GLL athletic activities. One copy needs to be given to the association, and one retained at home.  
**COMMON SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF CONCUSSION**  
 Headache, dizziness, poor balance, moves clumsily, reduced energy level/tiredness, nausea or vomiting, blurred vision, sensitivity to light and sounds, fogginess of memory, difficulty concentrating, slowed thought processes, confused about surroundings or game assignments, unexplained changes in behavior and personality  
 Loss of consciousness (NOTE: This does not occur in all concussion episodes.)  
**GLL CONCUSSION POLICY:** In accordance with Georgia law and national playing rules published by the National Federation of State High School Associations, any athlete who exhibits signs, symptoms, or behaviors consistent with a concussion shall be immediately removed from the practice or contest and shall not return to play until an appropriate health care professional has determined that no concussion has occurred. (NOTE: An appropriate health care professional may include, licensed physician (MD/DO) or another licensed individual under the supervision of a licensed physician, such as a nurse practitioner, physician assistant, or certified athletic trainer who has received training in concussion evaluation and management.  
 a) No athlete is allowed to return to a game or a practice on the same day that a concussion (a) has been diagnosed, OR (b) cannot be ruled out.  
 b) Any athlete diagnosed with a concussion shall be cleared medically by an appropriate health care professional prior to resuming participation in any future practice or contest. The formulation of a gradual return to play protocol shall be a part of the medical clearance.  
 c) It is mandatory that every GLL coach participate in a free, online course on concussion management prepared by the NFHS and available at www.nfhslearn.com at least every two years - beginning with the 2014 season.  
 d) Each association will be responsible for monitoring the participation of its coaches in the concussion management course, and shall keep a record of those who participate.
