

Scorekeeping Protocol 2015

- There is a scorekeeper's tutorial ([Scorekeeping 101](#)) on our website (tecolotbaseball.org) and the tips are very helpful.
- Official scorebooks/binders are at the fields (except Shetland) and should be left in the lock box on the field at the end of the last game on weekends, and at the end of weeknight games. Managers have the combo. However, each team should have their own scorebook for reference.
- Scores need to be entered for all divisions, except Shetland, to keep standings updated.
- Keeping accurate run totals is important. Standings may come down to tiebreakers, and run differentials may be sited.
- As a rule, Home Team is responsible for keeping the official score and then reporting the score, unless arrangements are made with the visiting team to report score.
- Please email all scores within 24 hours of the game to your respective manager, as they will be responsible for logging on to the website to enter game results.
- Mustang Division and above:
Please know your division's pitching rules.
Please list what pitchers pitch what inning **and** the number of pitches thrown on the scorebook page. As long as this is written down we are good. This is for reference to pitch counts. No need to email them with score.

Example:

Pitchers: Doe 1-2 (33 pitches), Jones 3-4 (48 pitches), Smith-5 (17 pitches), and Williams-6 (20 pitches)

- Please print your name and sign at the bottom of scorebook page at end of game.
- Please let me know if there were any OVER THE FENCE home runs, as we like to list on website.
