



DYHA team fundraising guidelines

- All fundraisers must be approved by the DYHA president or board prior to engaging in fundraising activities.
- Fundraising is optional.
- Funds are to be used for the team as a whole. They may not be prorated based on individual participation in fundraising or otherwise divided unevenly.
- The use of funds is determined by the team, (1 vote per player) and must be used for hockey related activities. Ex. End of year party, off-ice team building, extra tournament or offset dues.
- Teams are not allowed to solicit individuals or businesses for donations.
- All funds must be accounted for with the DYHA treasurer and the team.
 - Teams must designate a team treasurer that will be responsible for collecting and reporting funds.
 - Team income and expense must be reported at least once per month.
 - Teams may request approval from the DYHA President and Treasurer to setup a team account.
- Teams are strongly encouraged to spend the money they raise; any unused funds at the end of the season will be turned over to the DYHA general fund. Note: The High School team fund remains exempt from this rule.
