



Doug Clott and Melinda Roman Newton Girls Softball Scholarship

Scholarship Manager: Newton Girls Softball Scholarship Selection Committee

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 (one-time/non-renewing)

Fundraising: Newton Girls Softball raises funds through individual donations and corporate sponsors; the \$2,000 total proposed annual scholarship funding to two Newton high school seniors accounts for less than 2% of NGS's annual revenue.

Eligibility: The recipient should be a graduating senior who has (1) been accepted to and is attending an institution of higher learning the Fall following high school, has (2) played in Newton Girls Softball recreational or Panther programs for at least three seasons, and who (3) exemplifies the values of Newton Girls Softball.

Selection Process: The Scholarship Selection Committee of Newton Girls Softball, approved by the Executive Board, is responsible for the selection process. The Selection Committee includes Doug Clott, Melinda Roman, the sitting President of Newton Girls Softball, and the sitting Rec. League Commissioner, among others. Immediate family members of the Selection Committee are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.
