

PSD Grades Policy

Players with two F's are ineligible to play in games
(although they can practice)

Grade reports

PSD provides grade reports to the head coaches every Thursday.

- Coaches will contact players whose grades are an issue
- Players with two F's will be ineligible to play in games unless they improve their grades before the end of the following day (Friday)

Players with two F's must see their teachers immediately and find a way to improve their grades. If by Friday they do not have "written notice" (*see below for requirements*) from their teachers verifying that they have improved their grades, they will be ineligible to play in any games the following week.

"Written notice" requirements

If by Friday a player has "written notice" from his teachers that he has improved his grade, he must ensure the following takes place before the end of the school day on Friday in order to be eligible to play in games the following week:

- Give the "written notice" to his high school Athletic Director (AD)
- The AD will then send a letter to the Fort Collins Unified AD (Ken Denning at FRHS) and the District Lacrosse Head Coach verifying that the player has improved his grades

If the FCU AD and District Lacrosse Head Coach do not receive this letter before the end of the school day on Friday, that player will be ineligible the following Monday – Saturday to play in any game (although he is allowed to participate in practice).

Ineligibility due to previous semester grades

If a player ends the Fall semester with two F's, he has until the Friday immediately prior to March 10th to provide "written notice" that his grades have improved. Failure to do so will result in the player being ineligible for the entire Spring season.
