



Livermore Smoke Summer Kickoff 2014 Rules 10u, 12u and 14u Rules

1. All games will be played under 2014 ASA rules except where modified by these rules.
2. Each team will play 3 games in pool play on Saturday followed on Sunday by a single elimination tournament.
3. 7 innings for pool play and bracket play or no new inning may start after 70 minutes.
4. If after 7 innings the game is tied, on Saturday, the game ends in a tie. Games on Saturday can end in a tie.
5. International tie breaker will be used on Sunday, after time has expired or after 7 innings, until there is a winner.
6. Run rules are: 15 after 3, 12 after 4, and 8 after 5.
7. Championship game will be 7 innings long, with a 10 run rule in effect after 5 innings.
8. Game time is forfeit time.
9. There is no infield practice.
10. Team listed first will occupy the 3rd place dugout. Teams playing back to back games shall stay in the same dugout if they are on the same field.
11. Home team will be determined by a coin toss.
12. No protest. The umpires decisions are final.
13. Home team will keep official scorebook. The home team is responsible for reporting the scores to the field Marshall after each game.
14. All line up changes must go through the umpire.
15. Pool play seeding will be 10 points for a win, 5 points for a tie and 0 points for a loss.
16. Tie breaker is as follows: A) head to head record, B) fewest runs allowed, C) most runs scored, D) coin toss.
17. Game times and fields are subject to change by the tournament director.
18. Teams will be allowed to bring in a team cooler for beverages. No outside food allowed. This event is a major fundraiser for our travel teams. We ask that you please support us and them by utilizing our snack bar facilities for your food and beverage needs.
19. No dogs allowed. Most of our fields are ran by the school district and they are very strict about this. I know some of you travel from far away and I'd hate for you to have to lock your pet Ina car all day, so please arrange to leave them at home.
20. Per ASA rules, no jewelry is to be worn in tournament play, this is a safety issue which will be enforced. Best to take the earrings out before you drive to Livermore and put them back on when you get home. Tape or band-aids are not acceptable protection. The umpires will enforce this.
21. DP/Flex is allowed.
22. Highest seed will be home team on all Sunday games.
23. If any team is playing 4 games during pool play. The scores and results will be placed in a hat and a representative from another team will be asked to pick 3 of the 4 results from a hat. Those numbers will be used to determine their seeding for Sunday.
