## General Conduct

All questions and concerns about a game will be addressed at the following practice. Game day is a time to display good sportsmanship, maintain the integrity of the franchise, remember the nature and purpose of the event, and improve the overall outlook of our community.

All players, cheerleaders, coaches, volunteers, and visitors attending practice, games, or events should model great sportsmanship and respect at all times. Parents and guardians are responsible for relaying our expectations to guests (and the children) accompanying them at West Seattle Jr. Football & Cheer (WSJF&C) event. Violations by guests are considered violations by the Wildcat parent and player.

## Drugs, Tobacco, Alcohol, and Profanity

Tobacco products are permitted 100 yards away from practice and game fields. No drugs, alcohol, weapons, or profanity are permitted at or around WSJF&C facilities or events.

## Violations

The unlikely event of a code violation will result in a trespassing and suspension from functions sanctioned by WSJF and/or its affiliates unless and until the WSJF&C Board of Directors allows return. Illegal acts will be prosecuted.
