

**Refer to LLL Handbook and Majors Rules**

**The following rules supersede related handbook rules:**

Home Team does Scoreboard, Announcing

Dimensions for the Division will be **48\*** ft mounds, 65 foot bases

No balks

No Dropped 3<sup>rd</sup> strike rule

Pitch Count Rules:

If there is a problem with 2 innings per game, we are then relegated to LL rules on pitch count:

League Ages: 10 and under — 75 pitches per day

11-12 — 85 pitches per day

**Exception:** If a pitcher reaches the limit imposed in Regulation VI (c) for his/her league age while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch to that batter until any one of the following conditions occurs: 1. That batter reaches base; 2. That batter is put out; 3. The third out is made to complete the half-inning.

c. Pitchers league age 14 and under must adhere to the following rest requirements:

If a player pitches 66 or more pitches in a day, four (4) calendar days of rest must be observed.

If a player pitches 51–65 or more pitches in a day, four (3) calendar days of rest must be observed.

If a player pitches 36–50 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed.

If a player pitches 21–35 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar days of rest must be observed.

If a player pitches 1–20 pitches in a day, no (0) calendar day of rest must be observed

Lead Offs - 2 step maximum lead offs before the pitcher begins motion. No secondary or lead after pitcher begins motion. If the runner hasn't taken a lead before the motion, they can't lead off for that pitch. Pick offs allowed.

**\*Steals only after pitch crosses the plate**

Strike Zone: Letters to knees, hand's width outside and inside of plate.

10 run per inning max. No steals after 8 runs.

Fill in players allowed provided same age group or younger playing up. No ringers.

**\*Time Limit of 1-1/2 hours. No new inning after 1-1/2 Hours**
