

# Becoming A Hockey “On Ice” Helper Checklist

The following checklist is designed for anyone who wants to be an “On Ice” parent helper (**U6 and U8 divisions only**) for The Huron County Hockey Association. All of these steps need to be completed to obtain an “On Ice Helper” status.

1.  Register with USA Hockey (usahockey.com) as a volunteer. No Cost.
2.  Register with Huron County Hockey Association (huroncountyhockey.com) as a volunteer. No Cost. Please fill out the registration form in its entirety. Include confirmation number from USA Hockey and your date of birth as well as a good phone number where you can be reached and an email address.
3.  Complete background screening. A link can be found at the bottom of the front page on the Huron County Hockey’s website. (must have before any participation)
4.  Complete the Safe Sport training module, found on USA Hockey’s website. (must have before any participation)
5.  Not required but highly suggested that you complete the appropriate age specific module for the division you will be helping. These modules are found on USA Hockey’s website.
