




INAUGURAL MISSION TRAILS HIT-A-THON SATURDAY, APRIL 6, 2019



MTLL HIT-A-THON FAQs

What is a Hit-A-Thon?

A Hit-A-Thon is a cross between a home-run derby and a typical "A-Thon" fundraiser in which players raise money and win prizes partially based on the distance of that longest hit they have during that event. Think "Jog-A-Thon" or "Read-A-Thon", but with hitting baseballs instead of jogging and reading.

How does the Hit-A-Thon work?

Each player gets 10 attempts to hit the ball or 5 hits in play, whichever comes first. Majors & Minors players will receive up to 10 pitches from a pitching machine, and Caps & Tee Ball players will get 10 swings from a tee. The longest hit for each player, measured by the distance the ball traveled in the air, will be recorded. That distance or 100 feet, whichever is larger, will be entered into the players fundraising page after the event and will be used to determine the total amount for the per-foot donations.

How do I raise funds?

To make collecting pledges as simple as possible, we have enlisted the services of online fundraising platform 99pledges. Each player has their own personal fundraising page at which friends and family can pledge their support toward reaching your player's fundraising goal. The personal fundraising page can be shared via email, social media, or mobile text.

How do I find my player's fundraising page?

Each player in the league has their own personal page already set up for them and can be found in one of two ways:

1. Go to <https://99pledges.com/fund/2019MTLL> and search by your player's name.
2. 99pledges will email a link to a player's fundraising page directly to the email address(es) of their guardian(s).

What should I do when I find my player's fundraising page?

1. Make your donation immediately! This will inspire others to donate because they will see you believe in the cause.
2. Send your player's donation page to close friends and family and include a personal message. Ask them to make a donation as soon as they can so it can help get the ball rolling. It's a lot harder to dismiss a personal message.
3. Post a link to your player's donation page to Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc., and continue to do so a few times before the Hit-A-Thon. You'd be surprised how many casual friends would love to support your cause.
4. Be persistent! Friends and family who see your message more than once are much more likely to donate.

Are cash and check donations accepted as well?

Yes! However, only flat, fixed amount donations are accepted via cash or check, and they must be submitted to your team parent, manager, or MTLL board member on or before the day of the Hit-A-Thon. They will be manually entered into the player's fundraising page and will be counted toward their fundraising totals. Please remember to get an email address from the donor so we can give them a proper thank you!

How much money is each player expected to raise?

Each player has the goal of raising \$75 and must raise at least \$25 in order to be eligible for the prizes.

How can I help?

Aside from helping your player raise funds, there are plenty of volunteer opportunities the day of the Hit-A-Thon. Contact your team parent for details.
