



NJF is part of the Bay State Youth Football and Cheer Conference which operates under the rules of American Youth Football. These rules have been developed over time to ensure a fair and level playing field for all participants. The paperwork requirements below must be satisfied before a participant will be issued equipment or allowed onto a practice or playing field.

- General requirements
  - Must be photocopies, faxes or scans of original forms
  - Do NOT send original forms
  - Copies must be legible
  - Do NOT staple the forms
  
- Birth Certificates
  - Participant's name and date of birth must be visible
  - Date of birth must match the registration information
  - If possible, the raised stamp or seal should be visible in the photo-copy
  
- Medical Form
  - Participant's name and date of exam must be visible
  - The date must be on or after January 1 of the current year
  - Forms dated prior to January 1 must be accompanied by a letter from the doctor indicating the child is cleared to participate in the upcoming season
  
- Report Card
  - Purpose – Three primary reasons
    - To ensure the child attended school
    - To ensure the child attended a school in a town serviced by NJF
    - For possible academic awards – Participants at the D Team level and above are eligible for awards from NJF and AYP
  - Participant's name, the name of the school and the school year must be visible
  - Must show grades for the entire school year which ended in the spring prior to the current football season
