

GAME DAY DETAILS - Playoffs

Costs

- Trophies, Officials, EMT or trainer, Police detail (split between participating teams, reimbursement will take place within one week by participating teams. Host will send invoice via email and cc Bob)
- Field fees will be divided by entire conference evenly

Home/Away

- Higher seed sets up on venue's traditional home side.
- Away team calls coin toss
- Home Wears DARK Jerseys
- Home team provides chain crew, etc.

MPR's – The following may approach the MPR coaches at any time:

- Game Day Supervisor
- Executive Director
- Conference President
- Presidents
- MPR Monitors are Required for both playoff brackets (Regional and Presidents/local)
- MPR Coaches should be closely watched, without creating a distraction – communicate with each other
- MPR form the teams have been using is OK at all local (President's) level games & Round 1 of 2 of Regional.
 - Conf / State Championship needs AYF Form
- MPR #'s are the same.
- Make sure teams are ready to go at prior game's end.
- ANY Dispute regarding MPR's Will be handled:
 - During game
 - If monitor and MPR coach can not agree on the status of MPR's, then call in someone with a white BayState hat. If the dispute can not be handled during the natural flow of the game, the "white hat" can call an Official Time Out OR Advise the team that brought the dispute to file an official protest at the end of the game.

Accommodations:

- Game Day Supervisor (for each team & host) must schedules, previously communicated, and be available at all times.
- Any Conference member with a white conference hat is allowed anywhere in the venue.
- Practice Space
 - Walpole on lower field, except earliest game
 - Needham both far end on softball field (no baseball outfield if it is raining)
 - Natick on the old backfield
 - Milton in the end zones – "Away" in the concession end zone.
- Announcer set up by host – must be Enthusiastic, family friendly, neutral!
- Rain/Cold – Any accommodations you would like to make for your teams must be cleared with host in advance (tents, heaters)
- Concessions will be available for Entire game time, appropriate menu
- No Gate except for Cent MA Championship Round in Weymouth – Nov 13
- Venue provides equipment (chains, yard markers, end zone markers)
- Save Parking for trainer & 5 refs
- Lights for early arrival teams
- Please send rosters for the announcers. Email is ok, but please do so in advance.
- Site Directors/Game Day supervisors should introduce themselves to officials, sidelines coaches, chains, monitor, EMT
- Participating coaches
 - teams must stay 25-25,
 - no other coaches in the periphery
 - coaches from other teams/games must remain behind yellow line
 - Limit of 7 coaches in coaches box
 - No more than 1 coach on the field at a time
 - Coaches may not go onto the field any further than the numbers
- Slaughter Rule remains at 30 points
- Intersperse coaches into the handshake line.
