## Georgetown College

Georgetown College enrolls approximately 1000 students. The



student to teacher ratio is 9 to 1 and the average class size is 12 students. Fifteen students per semester are sent to study at Oxford University in England, including two Lacrosse players this year. 100% of students receive financial aid. NAIA Division I school (Equal to NCAA DII) in the NWLL West region. 2015 will be 2nd year of program with players representing 9 states and three countries. They run a high tempo offense and aggressive eight-man double team defense. Athletic scholarships are available.
