

## **Lemon Grove Little League - TEE BALL** **2015 LOCAL RULES SUPPLEMENTAL**

The emphasis of T-Ball is on instruction and upon having fun!

Good sportsmanship shall always be stressed. The following supplemental rules are to be considered the guide for Managers, coaches and parents.

Official Little League Rules from the “2015 Rules Manual” will apply unless superseded in the following Local League Rules.

1. No official score shall be maintained.
2. There shall not be an Umpire assigned to the games.
3. Each game shall be a maximum of 1 hour in duration.
4. An inning consists of all players batting once in consecutive order. The last batter shall run all bases.
5. All players are allowed to play defense. There will be a maximum of 5 infielders, not counting the catcher. Additional players shall play in the outfield. All outfielders shall be positioned on the outfield grass.
6. Catchers may play only if they are wearing a complete set of catchers’ protective gear.
7. Each player shall play infield and outfield at least once during the game. However the Manager shall exercise discretion for the safety of the players.
8. If a player becomes unable to bat because of sickness or injury, his or her place shall be skipped in the batting order.
9. A player arriving for a game after the game has started shall be placed at the end of the batting order.
10. The team on defense is allowed up to three coaches to assist in the outfield.
11. The Manager or coach of the team on offense shall place the ball on the batting Tee.
12. There shall be a team parent, coach, or Manager in the dugout of each team at all times during the game.
13. All players shall hit from the tee. There will be no pitching to the players by the coaches. Additionally there are no strikeouts.

## 2015 T-Ball Supplemental Rules continued

14. A ball not hit the minimum distance (outside of the minimum arc) is considered to be a foul ball.
15. Batters are not allowed to be “on deck”.
16. All batters and base runners shall wear protective helmets.
17. A player shall not throw the bat after hitting the ball. Throwing the bat will result in a warning. On the second offense, by the same batter, the player shall be called out, and removed from the base. He or she shall immediately return to the dugout. Other base runners, if any, shall return to their previous “on base” positions.
18. Runners may advance only 1 base per play.
19. Players are to avoid collisions at all times.
20. If a play is to be made at home plate, the runner **MUST** avoid contact by going around catcher.
21. The designated “Home” team shall prepare the field for play, prior to the start of the game.
22. Both teams are responsible for cleaning up the field and returning all bases and league equipment to the “Caps” shed after the game.
