

## RFL FINANCIAL AID POLICY

The Rockville Football League (RFL) has established a new financial aid policy and process for those that qualify for help in meeting registration costs.

**Rockville City Residents:** should continue to contact the Rockville City Park and Recreation Department at City Hall to apply for assistance.

**Non-Rockville City Residents:** For those outside the city proper. Complete the financial aid application and provide the required documentation plus a \$110 co-pay for RFL players.

The RFL has also established a Sponsor Matching Funds program to help those who meet the requirements. We also have a program for those who may not qualify but have a temporary circumstance that requires assistance for a child to play football. This is done through our Qualified Sponsor program.

A qualified sponsor is a professional firm, business or individual not related to the recipient who provides a check made out to the Rockville Football League. The RFL will match any amounts contributed by the Sponsor.

Example 1: ABC Attorneys at Law would like to sponsor an MSFL player and contribute \$100. The RFL will match the \$100 leaving \$25. \$25 will be paid by the player's family at registration.

Example 2:

XYZ Heating and Air Conditioning would like to sponsor an RFL player for \$80. The RFL will match the \$80 leaving \$65. The \$65 dollars will be paid by the player's family at registration.

All Sponsor checks must include the players name on the Memo line and be received before the player can register.
