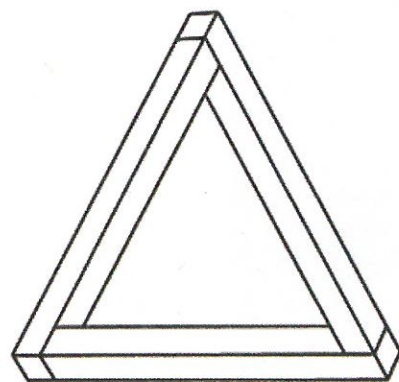

Tyrone were almost unique among New York clubs for the past few seasons – whereas many others have playing squads drafted from far and wide in Ireland, the players have been made almost exclusively in Tyrone: of the 32 players on the panel last year, 31 came from Tyrone with Downman Marty Hughes the only blow-in, so the Junior Championship victory was clearly founded on a tight-knit spirit borne out of that shared background.

The club has also managed to build on the Junior-winning panel, largely due to our northern rivals Derry folding this year due to lack of numbers. The addition of Darren Doherty, Joe Bell, Paul Mulhern, Conor Downey, Aidan Power, Darren Petite and Stevie Keating has provided them with a solid home base and boosted the team for the 2009 season.
