The new USA Baseball bat standard, or USABat, is in full effect. What does this mean for you? If your youth league is governed by any of the organizations listed below, then you will have to purchase a new bat for legal play starting January 1st, 2018.

- AMERICAN AMATEUR BASEBALL CONGRESS (AABC) ◆
- BABE RUTH/CAL RIPKEN BASEBALL ◆
- DIXIE BOYS AND DIXIE YOUTH BASEBALL ◆
- LITTLE LEAGUE AND PONY LEAGUE BASEBALL ◆

The above leagues will also allow 2 5/8" barrel bats to be used in competitive play, provided they meet USABat regulations. To identify officially-sanctioned youth bats, look for the "USA Baseball" licensing mark, located on the taper. T-ball regulations will not be changing, but these bats will now require the USA Baseball T-ball mark. All new 2018 T-ball bats will include this mark and be legal for play. If you already bought a T-ball bat without the USA Baseball mark, you can buy a sticker at [www.usabaseballshop.com](http://www.usabaseballshop.com) to make your bat legal for 2018 and beyond.

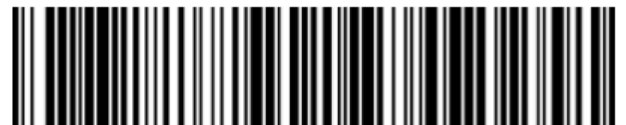
