Registration Dates

Walk Up registration will be at the OLL fields on the following dates.

November 5th
November 19st
December 3rd

Walk-up registration steps

- Complete and turn in the following forms (one for each player)
 - Player registration
 - Medical release
 - Volunteer application (*See Notes below*)
 - Parent & Player pledge

- Turn in copies of the following items (OLL can make copies at walk up registration)
 - Driver's license for each volunteer application (required for each parent/guardian).
 - Original birth certificate (abstract will NOT be accepted).
 - One of the following two (*See Notes Below*)
 - Three proofs or residency (a single utility bill can only be used once).
 - The School Enrollment Form if you attend a school in our boundaries (in place of the three proofs).

Bring all of the above, plus payment to the orange little league snack bar on one of the registration dates listed above.

This year OLL is increasing the sibling discount from \$10 to \$20 per sibling after the 1st player.

Registration Fee Discount Programs

Thanks to Orange Youth Sports (OYS) and everyone who worked at Polynesian Street during the Orange International Street Fair we are able to offer two promotion programs for registration.

First, Everyone who registers this Saturday will receive \$20 off all registrations, thanks to OYS. And, everyone who registers at our next (November 19th) walkup registration gets \$15 off all registrations thanks to OYS.

Second, Thanks to OYS, we are also introducing a Bring-A-Buddy program. If you bring a buddy, who has never played at OLL, you get \$30 off of your registration fee!!! Please let us know at registration if you are referring someone, and have the person you are referring, mention your name. The Bring-A-Buddy discount will be applied as a rebate after the buddy and the bringer are both completely registered.

We still have our standard sibling discount. For every second, third, fourth, etc. siblings a family receives a \$20 discount off their registration total.

Volunteer Application Notes

At Orange Little League player safety is the number one priority. So, all volunteers must submit to a background check. The information for the background check is collected on the volunteer applications.

There are two volunteer application forms. One is the "Returning Volunteer Application" form, the other is the "Volunteer Application" form.

Returning Volunteer Application

If a volunteer filled out either a Volunteer Application form or a Returning Volunteer Application form last year, this year the volunteer should fill out the Returning Volunteer Application. The Returning Volunteer Form only requires information on the left side of the form. The information on the right side of the form only needs to be filled out if it has changed since last year. So, the Returning Volunteer Form should be easier to fill out.

Volunteer Application

If the volunteer did not fill out a Volunteer Application last year they must fill out the Volunteer Application.

Proof of Residency Notes

Little League International has very strict proof of residency requirements for all leagues. Orange Little League must provide Proof of Residency documentation to Little League International upon request. So, we must collect this information as part of the registration process.

Little League International will accept two forms of Proof of Residency.

Proof of Residency by School Enrollment Form

The simplest Proof of Residency is a completed “School Enrollment Form”. If the player attends any one of the schools in the following table they are eligible to play at OLL regardless of where they live. The School Enrollment form must be signed by a school administrator, principal, or vice principal. One completed and signed School Enrollment Form satisfies Little League International’s proof of residency requirements.

Proof of Residency by 3 Proofs

If the player does not attend one of the schools listed above, or the family wishes to use “3 Proofs of Residency” method, copies of three items from the following list must be supplied to OLL at registration. The most common 3 Proofs of residency are; Drivers License, one bill, and vehicle registration. (This list is taken from Little League International documents.)

1. Driver’s License
2. Voter’s Registration
3. School records
4. Welfare/child care records
5. Federal records
6. State records
7. Local (municipal) records
8. Support payment records
9. Homeowner or tenant records
10. Utility bills (i.e., gas, electric, water/sewer, phone, mobile phone, heating, waste disposal)
11. Financial (loan, credit, investments, etc.) records
12. Insurance documents
13. Medical records
14. Military records
15. Internet, cable or satellite records

- 16. Vehicle records
- 17. Employment records

NOTE: Example - Three utility bills (three items from No. 10 above) constitute only ONE document.

Proof of Residency by Waiver

There is a situation where Little League International will waive the Residency Requirements. From Little League International:

If a person had previously resided within the league boundaries for two years while serving that league as a dedicated manager, coach or member of the Local League Board of Directors for two years, his or her sons and/or daughters are eligible to try out and be selected by teams in that league...

In such circumstances, a player may request a “Regulation IV(h) Waiver Claim Form”. This form must be filled out, and signed, by the OLL president, and verified by a district administrator as part of the registration process.
