### 1. New for 2014

Little League is pleased to announce significant changes to our program for the 2014 season.

- Seven year olds can now play (see section 7, “Age Determination”)
- 7 & 8 yr old division players will be allowed to register and play together as groups. If you register 6 players as a group and nominate a Manager, we will work to keep these players together on the same team.
- As an additional option, if you build a team of 13 players and nominate a Manager we will name your team after your designated elementary school’s mascot.
- There are new age groupings and divisions of play (Section 10)
  - 7 & 8 yr olds (‘A’ division)
  - 9 & 10 yr old drafted division (Supreme division)
  - 9 & 10 yr old non-drafted division (‘AA’ division)
  - 11 – 12 yr old drafted division (Majors division)
  - 11 -12 yr old non-drafted division (‘AAA’ division)
  - 11 – 12 yr old Premier division (“50/70”)

#### 4. Residency Requirements

Naperville Little League players must live within Naperville's city limits or School Districts 203 or 204 boundaries.

#### 5. Registration Dates & Payment

Any player wishing to try out for 9 & 10 yr old or 11 & 12 yr old Majors must register prior to Feb. 1, 2014.

All other players must register before March 16, 2014 to ensure preferred team placement for your player.

Registration fees increase after March 16, 2014.

Registration and payment must be completed online at [www.napervillelittleleague.org](http://www.napervillelittleleague.org).

Only Visa or MasterCard is accepted.

#### 6. Registration Fees

Registration fees are as follows:

- 11 – 12 yr old **Premier** (50/70)Division \$495
- 11 – 12 yr old **Majors** Division \$275
- 11- 12 yr old **“AAA”** Division \$175
- 9 – 10 yr old **Supreme** Division \$275
- 9 – 10 yr old **“AA”** Division \$175
- 7 & 8 yr old **“A”** Division \$100

Registration fees will increase by \$50 after March 16, 2014.

Returning Majors players will pay \$275 at time of registration.

All AA and AAA players will pay \$175 at time of registration. If after tryouts, your player is drafted a Supreme or Majors team, an additional \$100 will be collected by the Team's Manager prior to the beginning of the season.

Refunds prior to April 1, 2014 will be made less a \$50 processing fee; no refunds after April 1, 2014.

Naperville Little League provides each player with a uniform (MLB hat, jersey, socks). The Premier Division also includes an upscale uniform, bat bag, and batting helmet

Little League offers a \$10 discount for a second family member.

## 7. Age Determination

Naperville Little League is open to boys and girls ages 7 to 12 depending on their birthdate.

Players will be playing or competing in tryouts in the following Divisions based on their age and/or ability.

- A - Minimum age of 7 as of April 30, 2014 - Maximum age 9 as of September 02, 2014.
- AA/Supreme - Min. age of 9 as of Sept. 01, 2014 - Max. age 11 as of Sept. 02, 2014. AA Players who turn 9 from May 01, 2014 to Sept. 01, 2014 have the option of playing in the A division and trying out for the Supreme Division depending on their experience and or grade level.
- AAA/Majors - Min. age of 11 as of Sept. 01, 2014, Max. age of 13 as of May 01, 2014. AAA Players who turn 11 from May 01, 2014 to Sept. 01, 2014 have the option of playing in the AA division and trying out for the Supreme and Majors divisions depending on their experience and or grade level.

Little League International uses the player's age as of April 30th to determine the playing age for the season. NLLB uses September 1st the same as the local school districts to determine playing age for the divisions in which we have an option. This causes overlap in eligibility in some of divisions of play as outlined above. It is ultimately up to the player's ability, grade level and or the parent's decision on where these particular players are placed. When signing your player up, please choose the non-drafted division (within our guidelines) that is best suited for your player. This will be the division they will play in if they choose not to try-out or are not drafted into the Supreme or Majors divisions. Try-outs for these divisions will begin February 01, 2014. You can find out more information about our programs and try-out dates in the General Information Packet publication on our website.

### **8. Proof of Age & Residency**

Players new to Naperville Little League must provide proof of age and proof of residency.

Proof of age is a copy of the player's birth certificate.

Proof of residency consists of two documents showing the address of the legal residence of the parent(s) or court-appointed guardian(s) for the player(s). These can include a driver's license, an electric or other utility bill, or a financial record like a credit card or loan statement.

After registering you must deliver a copy of the player's birth certificate and proof of residency to the Little League office via one of these methods:

No new player to Naperville Little League will be considered registered for the program unless a birth certificate and proof of residency has been provided. If these documents are not provided before two weeks prior to opening day, your registration fee will be refunded less a \$50 service fee. Opening day dates are listed above.

### **9. What League am I In?**

Naperville Little League has four separate leagues, arranged by elementary school borders which feed into District 203 and 204 High Schools. The elementary school boundary in which your player resides determines which league you are in.

#### **National League: Naperville North High School**

Elementary School borders: Beebee, Ellsworth, Highlands, Meadow Glens (NN), Mill St., Naper, Prairie, and Steeple Run

#### **American - United League: Waubonsie, Metea and sections of Neuqua Valley High School**

Elementary School borders: Brookdale, Brooks, Cowlishaw, Fry, Georgetown, Gombert, Longwood, May Watts, McCarty, Owen, Peterson, Steck, Welch, White Eagle and Young

#### **Continental League: Naperville Central High School**

Elementary School borders: Elmwood, Kingsley, Maplebrook, Meadow Glens (NC), Ranchview, Riverwoods and Scott

#### **Republic League: Neuqua Valley High School**

Elementary School borders: Bulta, Clow, Graham, Kendal, Patterson, and Springbrook

#### **Other areas served:**

Naperville residents located in school district 200 are in the National League and Naperville residents located in school district 202 are in the Republic League.

### **10. Divisions or Levels of Play**

Naperville Little League has five divisions or levels of play.

**Premier (50/70) Division** is the highest level of play. The 50 stands for the distance in feet between the pitcher's mound and home plate and the 70 is the distance between the bases. The normal little League field utilizes a 46' pitching distance and 60' base paths. Players can lead-off bases and use big barrel (2 5/8") bats. Pitchers can pick-off players that stray too far from away from their base.

There are 12 players per team. The teams will play other Naperville Little League 50/70 clubs and travel to or host Chicago land Little League teams. Each player will receive an upscale uniform, which includes a vest style jersey, two undershirts (long and short sleeve), pants, socks, hat, batting helmet and matching bat bag.

After the regular season and City Championship Tournament, All-Star teams will compete to win a State Title and a chance to go to Little League's 50/70 World Series Tournament.

Tryouts for the Premier Division are already completed and teams have been formed.

In 2015 this Division will be open to 11 – 13 yr olds.

**11 – 12 yr old Majors Division** is the next highest level of play. Players must attend the tryouts and be drafted to participate. There are 12 players per team. Players in this league are expected to participate in

most if not all practices and games. This league plays some night games at 8:00 pm on lighted fields. This Division will play up to 22 regular season games with some games on 50/70 fields on Sundays. Teams will receive upscale uniforms.

After the regular season, teams will compete in League and City Championship tournaments. All-Star teams will form with a chance to win State titles and 12 year olds can advance all the way to the Little League World Series in Williamsport, PA.

**9 – 10 yr old Supreme Division** is for 9 and 10 year old players who want to play more games at a higher level. There will be a limited number of teams per league and players will be able to steal bases and advance at their own risk. Teams will play up to a 22 game schedule and receive upscale uniforms.

Teams will compete in a City Championship Tournament. All-Star teams will form with a chance to win a State title and play in year-end All-Star Tournaments. Some games will be played at 8:00 pm on lighted fields.

**AA, and AAA Divisions** are for players who do not desire to play or were not selected to a Supreme, Majors or Premier Division team. Twelve year olds as of 4/30/13 cannot pitch in the AAA Division. Players will play up to a 20 game season and receive MLB replica uniforms. Both of these Divisions will compete to participate in a City Tournament at the end of the season.

**7 & 8 yr old 'A' Division** will introduce our future Supreme, Majors, and Premier Division players to Naperville Little League Baseball. These teams will play up to an 18 game schedule with the first nine games using a pitching machine and the balance of the games with players pitching. The season will run from May through June and All-Star teams will be formed to play in yearend tournaments. Each player will receive a replica Major League uniform. All teams play at local Naperville Park District ball fields.

Little League will allow players to play together as a group using one of these two options:

1. Nominate 6 players to stay together as a group and nominate a Manager for the team. These six players will be combined with another group of six players or with individual registrants, to form a team.
2. Nominate 12-13 players to form a complete team and nominate a Manager for the team. If you do this Little League will name your team after your designated elementary school's mascot.

Little League will strive to make the first option work, but if the numbers don't work out adjustments may need to be made.

To avail you of one of these options contact Little League for the proper procedure to follow.

The A, AA, and AAA Division teams will usually have 12 -13 players on a team depending on enrollment. In general we try to keep kids from the same school and grade together in these leagues but there is no guarantee this will always be possible.

### 12. Managers, Coaches, and Other Volunteers

Little League is a volunteer organization. Your child will enjoy a great experience this summer because volunteers contributed their time. Won't you help too? This is a community service you can participate in and be proud of.

In order for Little League to be successful we need team Managers and Coaches. The Manager runs the team and is assisted by coaches. The Manager is the primary contact with Little League and parents. Teaching kids baseball skills is a shared responsibility for the Manager, Coaches, and parents.

Little League offers coaching clinics during the winter to help you become a better coach and teach proper baseball skills. You must register to attend the clinics. For more information see "Coaches' Clinics" below.

In addition to Managers and Coaches, Little League has many volunteer opportunities you can participate in and are vital to the program. Examples are umpire coordinators, clerical, data entry, IT, adult umpires, web design, handyman, field maintenance, marketing/promotion, help with social media, equipment distribution / return, and many other tasks.

Little League's number one goal is the safety of children in the program. All Managers, Coaches, and other adult volunteers are required to sign off on a "Naperville Little League Code of Conduct" and fill out a "Little League Volunteer Application" form and deliver them to our office. The volunteer form requires a social security number and a photocopy of a government issued identification as background checks are conducted on all volunteers. The forms will be made available at [www.napervillelittleleague.org](http://www.napervillelittleleague.org). This is required annually even if you filled out the form in the past. ### Coaches' Clinics

Naperville Little League is partnering with the Bulls Sox Academy (BSA) to offer coaching clinics.

These clinics are open to all Naperville Little League Managers, Coaches, and parents interested in upgrading their coaching skills at all levels of play.

Three separate clinics will be held during the winter and an additional outdoor clinic will be held in April to cover skills and drills on the field.

The dates for these clinics are as follows:

### **13. More Baseball**

After the City Championship is completed a **Summer Tournament** will be offered (at additional cost) to all players wishing to play additional baseball. Teams are formed by age groups and umpires are used for all games. This tournament runs through the end of July concluding with a championship game. Trophies are awarded to the top two teams in all levels except the 'A' division.

After the kids go back to school, Naperville Little League offers **Fall Ball** to all players younger than 12 years old as of 4/30/14. This program is formed by age groups, games are played at Naperville Park District premier lighted fields, include new jerseys & hats, and utilize umpires for all games. There are no standings kept in this league.

### 14. Sponsors

### **15. Umpires**

Naperville Little League provides umpires for games at all levels of play. Younger and new umpires are used for the 7 & 8 and AA divisions, and more experienced umpires are used for the AAA, Supreme, and Majors.

Little League compensates our youth umpires on a per game basis.

Our program has adult umpires who volunteer their time as well. Although umpires older than 21 will not be paid for their services, Little League will provide any adult who commits to umpire 10 games with a complete set of umpire gear to keep.

Little League offers umpire clinics through the Park District in the spring that all umpires are expected to attend.

If you have a child who is 13 years old as of April 30, 2014 or older and wishes to umpire, monitor our website starting in March for more information.
